

The **Caribbean Migration Consultations (CMC)** is a process initiated by the Caribbean countries in 2016, as a space for dialogue among decision makers, experts on migration and other stakeholders, offering a cooperation framework to address migration issues.

In this regard, the CMC has held several meetings and workshops, helping create networks among specialized actors in various priority topics related to migration and refugee protection identified by participating countries and territories.
