

The **Caribbean Migration Consultations (CMC)** is a process initiated by the Caribbean countries in 2016, as a space for dialogue between decision makers, experts on migration and other stakeholders, offering a cooperation framework to meet on an equal footing to address migration issues and to ensure the protection of refugees, on both common and unique concern.

In this regard, the CMC have held several meetings and workshops, helping create networks between specialized actors in various themes related to migration and refugee protection, specifically on priorities identified by participating countries and territories.
